A Hands on Workshop: Restoring a Class IV with Composite

Course Synopsis

When done properly, direct bonding is truly the most creative dental treatment that today's dentist can render. For clinicians, there are difficulties that make material selection a stressful experience. Without proper shade selection or preparation, the results can be unpredictable at best and esthetically unacceptable at worst.

This course is designed for clinicians seeking to improve their skills in order to confidently restore Class IV cases, from simple to complex. Layering techniques taught in the course will enable the participants to create life-like esthetically pleasing restorations. Polishing and finishing techniques will be reviewed in detail and a step-by-step procedural approach to solving daily anterior challenges will be presented.

- Understanding of layering techniques required to produce natural esthetics
- Exploring various finishing and polishing techniques for creating natural esthetics
